JAN HUTCHINSON — Camp Director, head coach at Bloomsburg University is the nation's winningest collegiate field hockey coach with 565 wins, 74 losses and 20 ties. Bloomsburg teams have won 15 national championships, including 4 years in a row, from 1996 - 1999, a feat unparalleled by any college in any division. Bloomsburg has also finished as national runner-up in 9 other years. Hutchinson was named National Coach of the Year in 1991, 1998, 2004 and 2007. As head coach of the softball team, her record is 1130 - 269 - 2, the nation's winningest D-II softball coach. Although retiring in June 2010, Hutchinson will direct the 2010 camps.

GARY AGARD — Assistant field hockey and lacrosse coach at Bloomsburg. Gary is a former member of the Trinidad National Men's Team.

NIKKI HARTRANFT RHODES — A 2004 Bloomsburg graduate and two-time All-American, Nikki is the Head Coach at Alvernia College.

BLAIR WYNNE—Current member of the Senior Women's National team from Trinidad. Lock Haven University graduate.

CARA SENESE— Head coach at East Stroudsburg High School. Former All-American at East Stroudsburg University. Former member of the US National Indoor team.

NEIL LASHLEY — Former member and captain of the Trinidad National Team.

RACHEL ALLISON — Head coach at Houghton College.

TRACEY HUDAK — 3-time All-American goalie at Bloomsburg.

ELLIS CHANCE — Former member of Men's Junior and Senior National Teams from Trinidad.

SHARLA PARTLON — Former All American midfielder and Division II National Player of the Year for Bloomsburg.

JAMAL GROSVENOR — Former member of the US Junior Men's National Team.

MARLEA PARTLON — Former Bloomsburg All American and current Assistant Coach at Nashaminy High School.

SHAWN HINDY—Head coach of the US Women's National Indoor team and current head coach at Lehigh Valley High School.

MELISSA MARTIN—Wake Forest University. Former member of the US National Under-21 team.

RANDY CHRISTIE—Former member of the US National Men's Team.

BRETT DUNN—Goalkeeper coach for the University of Richmond and former goalkeeper for the US Men's Under-21 National Team.

Information



The University

Bloomsburg University is one of 14 universities in the State System of Higher Education. The University currently serves the educational needs of 7,200 undergraduate and graduate students in 100 programs of study. Bloomsburg is served by the Greyhound and Susquehanna Trailways bus lines.

Medical Care & Insurance

Although Bloomsburg University maintains a complete athletic training room for the treatment of minor injuries, illness or injury requiring medical treatment, hospitalization and/or surgery will be referred to The Bloomsburg Hospital.

For this reason, the parent or guardian of each camper must sign the camp registration form, granting permission to administer appropriate medical attention if necessary. Bloomsburg University does not provide medical insurance for young people attending its summer camps.

Should hospitalization and/or the care of a physician be needed, the camper must use his or her medical insurance plan for payment of medical services. All campers must have insurance to attend camp.

Camp Rules

Campers are expected to attend all scheduled sessions and to heed the University's rules of decorum. Specifically, smoking tobacco, possession or consumption of illegal drugs and the use of alcoholic beverages are strictly forbidden. Flagrant misconduct will subject the camper to immediate dismissal without refund of camp fees. Resident campers are also not permitted to drive their personal vehicles while enrolled in camp. Keys to private vehicles must remain in the custody of the director for the duration of camp.

Hazing and initiations will not be tolerated in camp.

Bloomsburg is located 75 miles from the PA/NJ border on Rt 80. From Rt 80 take exit 236 - merge onto Rt 487 south. Go to the second traffic light (Country Club Drive) - turn right to the athletic fields, turn left for the dormitories.

From south - PA turnpike north to Rt. 80 west - then follow above directions.

From south and west via Rt. 11 - Rt. 11 north to Bloomsburg proceed up the Main Street of town - turn left onto Rt. 487 North to traffic light (Country Club Drive) - turn right for dormitories, left for fields.
